# SOUTH AFRICAN COLLECTIVE ART NBLACK

Curated by Allana Foster-Finley



The Art in Black Foundation proudly presents the South African Collective, the inaugural curatorial showcase led by Allana Foster Finley of Cur8Africa. This debut exhibition—launching at the 2025 American Black Film Festival in Miami Beach, June 11–14—brings South African visual art into powerful conversation with the worlds of film, media, and storytelling.

Curated on behalf of the Art in Black Foundation—founded in 2024 by Ellis Friday, a visionary young creative committed to cultural connection, with the support of his parents, Nicole and Jeff Friday—this collective reflects a bold dedication to building lasting platforms for African artists. The idea was sparked during an immersive art tour through South Africa, experienced by Jeff Friday and led by Allana Foster Finley earlier this year. That journey uncovered a wealth of talent and vision that now anchors this dynamic exhibition.

The South African Collective introduces these artists to the American Black Film Festival (ABFF) community, expanding the cultural dialogue between visual art, film, and television.

# MEETTHEARTISTS





Steve Maphoso, a self-taught Angolan-born artist, uses acrylic and charcoal to explore emotional states rooted in personal experience. His portraits—focused on expressive eyes and layered with cloud-like abstractions—are poetic meditations on love, memory and connection. His latest body of work introduces a symbolic narrative of twin boys who have migrated from an ancient age, guided by ancestral intent for the artist to initiate them into traditional rituals in Mpumalanga. These works explore themes of heritage, migration, and the intimacy of brotherhood, reflecting a journey into parenthood and personal transformation. Maphoso invites viewers into his world—where grief and beauty converge, tradition meets evolution, and the intangible becomes momentarily graspable.

Thabiso Dakamela, born in 1994 to a Venda father and Ndebele mother, draws inspiration from daily life and cultural duality, creating work that explores identity, emotion, and interconnectedness. With over a decade of professional experience, his expressive, Afrocentric style—marked by emotive brushwork and rich contrasts—has earned him local and international acclaim. Featured in The Art Times Magazine and SABC's Mzansi Insider, Dakamela's art delves into the light and dark aspects of the human experience, often using shades of blue to evoke introspection, strength, and vulnerability. He is also the founder of the DKS Project House, supporting emerging artists with resources and space to grow.

Assan Taylor is a self-taught artist known for vibrant, textured portraits that blend traditional and contemporary techniques. Using charcoal, oil and acrylic paint, newspaper print, gold leaf and netting, he explores identity, culture, and human connection. Born in Southern Africa and now based at Ellis House Art Building, his bold, expressive style aims to inspire empathy and connection while pushing the boundaries of contemporary art.



Siyabonga Mlambi, born in Bizana in South Africa's Eastern Cape, draws deep inspiration from his culturally rich roots—also home to icons like Winnie Madikizela-Mandela and Oliver Tambo. A lifelong passion for art led him to study design, where he developed a distinctive mixed-media approach using acrylic, fabric, stones, ink, and found materials. His signature style, Khanda-Art Superblur African Synthetic Cubism, blends vibrant colour, movement, and emotion through elements like lines, shapes, and texture. Rooted in the Nguni concept of "Khanda"—to create from scratch—his work celebrates unity, imagination, and positivity, inviting viewers to feel beauty beyond what the eye can see.



Ayanda Moyo is a Zimbabwean artist known for evocative works in charcoal, oil, and acrylics. Through bold strokes and emotive pieces, Moyo explores themes of identity, culture, and human experience. With a passion for storytelling, Moyo's art invites viewers to reflect on the world around them.
